To the general public and donors that give to The Believers Worship Center, Inc. (TBWC), I would like to inform you that our church organization has been falsely accused by the Prince George's County Government Office of Audits and Investigations for misusing funds pertaining to a \$8,500 grant. The grant in question was never applied for or used by The Believers Worship Center, Inc. However, See the other Side, Inc., which is a separate organization, received the \$8,500 grant for its Outreach program. What may have been a point of confusion for the County is the fact that the Director of See The Other Side, Inc. is a member of TBWC and the grant was used to serve his work with the Prince George's County Prison Reform System. The County records indicated that the funds for this particular grant were "misused" by TBWC from 2009 – 2010. While in fact, TBWC has never completed any forms or documentation with The Prince George's County Council for a grant of this amount (\$8,500).

The Prince George's County Office of Audits and Investigations requested an audit with TBWC. We complied with the audit and submitted every requested document to them. Their audit found no evidence that TBWC signed off on any document requesting a grant or that TBWC used the grant. In fact, as the senior Pastor of TBWC, my signature would be required on any grant request or documents associated with a grant request. There are no such documents in their records.

I conclude by saying that TBWC has disputed this claim and has asked the County to remove this false claim against The Believers Worship Center, Inc.
